She further stated that the Outhouse Company had been cited for failing to maintain trip tickets and other issues had been discovered during the investigation.

City Manager's Report

City Manager Knight stated that the quotes on the fencing and the concrete pad were being sought for the utility warehouse and moving forward toward the completion.

Knight also reported that the skate park was complete and was being utilized. Signage is being ordered stating that skaters skate at their own risk.

Knight further reported that the filters and pumps were not yet in for the arsenic remediation but they were supposed to be in by the end of the month.

Knight lastly reported that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality had cited the City for lack of a backflow preventer on the fire hydrant where bulk water is obtained. The City sells this bulk water to different companies. He also noted that there is nothing in the code of ordinances concerning the sale of bulk water and that the City had been selling it for over 20 years. He will be bringing something back to Council at a later date.

City Secretary Report

City Secretary Melissa Brunner reported that she was continuing to make progress on the new map of Oak Hill Cemetery. She further reported that Early voting will take place May 2-6 from 8-5 and also on May 9 and 10 from 7-7.

Police Chief's Report

Chief Noak presented the March 2011 Police Report. Noak also reported that the people who'd completed the training for Citizens on Patrol were Mr. Cooper, Betty Gabler, Lisa Branecky and Anthony Cooper.

Fire Department

The Flatonia Volunteer Fire Department received \$2,263.72 for the last quarter's donation monies. This brings the total in that account to \$27,577.22.
