Agenda Item: Consider and take appropriate action on adding or removing potential projects from the projects list set forth in attached Exhibit A and which the Corporation desires to undertake in the future.

Exhibit A

- 1. Streetlight upgrades- We have \$9750.00 remaining to be used.
- 2. Restrooms at 7-Acre Park (funding \$8,000 re-appropriated funding to FY 21 via ordinance 2021.2.1). We are waiting on estimates that we believe will be \$25,000.00 need to add this to the budget for 2022-2023.
- 3. Demolition of Grifaldo house and salvage material. Use Grifaldo property for an exit for buses and traffic exiting the park.
- 4. Informational and 10 directional sign locations TBS. TxDot partnership for ROW. Funding needed. Signage Need to get some signage near the Freeway, Old Spanish Trail signs and way finding signs. Jack has been working with TxDot. We will need to get a map of where we want them for him to send to TxDot.
- 5. Need to get the business survey sent out with the utility bills.
- 6. Sidewalk extension at the railroad crossings on the west side of Market St and an ongoing collaborative effort between UP and city.
- 7. Consider putting a t-ball field on the left side next to the splash pad. Jack and Travis will provide a drawing for the t-ball field.
- 8. Need to get with local businesses to discuss the zip code analysis.
- 9. Removal of asbestos from the old fire station.
- 10. Conversion of wastewater treatment facility to mechanical plant.
- 11. Water line extension on Garbade Lane to Hackberry St.
- 12. Garbade Lane straighten and extend from 11th ST. to Hackberry St.
- 13. Market St. extension to I-10 frontage road.
- 14. Nikel-Mica waterline extension to finish looping the system.
- 15. Water Main on Jares Lane and I-10 frontage back to FM609.
- 16. CARTS/AMTRAK Terminal and parking area.
- 17. New back-up generator for Wastewater Treatment Plant.
