

The City of Flatonia City Council voted for Ordinance 2025.12.2 to increase electric rates. This adjustment reflects rising operational and infrastructure costs necessary to maintain reliable electric service. Below is a table outlining the changes. We remain committed to providing safe, dependable power and appreciate your understanding. **This change will be effective April 1, 2026.**

New Electric Rates and Bill Impact

The numbers above only reflect the electric portion of the utility bill for City of Flatonia customers.

It is based on an average of 1000 kilowatt-hours per month of service.

The proposed rate increase applies only to base charges (customer charge and energy charge), while the Power Cost Recovery Factor is not changed because the PCRF is charged as a pass-through.

PCRF – Is the purchase cost of power from LCRA
