Opening Agenda

Call to Order Committee Chair Targac called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.
Citizen Participation None

Projects/Reports

1. City Manager Miller updated the Committee that the LCRA Community Grant Program Application was not selected for award.
2. City Manager Miller updated the Committee that the Texas Parks and Wildlife Trail Grant is in progress. The environmental study has been complete and the next stage will begin in early 2026.

Consent Agenda

1. Committee member Stavinoha moved, with a second from Committee member Horn, to approve the meeting minutes from August 27, 2025. The vote was unanimous. The motion carried.

Discussion Agenda

1. City Manager Miller proposed adding a privacy fence on the south property line by the soccer field and on the first base side of the softball field. Committee member Sears suggested adding a roof over the swimming pool bathrooms.
2. City Manger Miller went over the details on how to create a 501(c)(3) for the Parks Committee. This will allow the committee to be tax exempt and apply for grants. Committee member Horn suggested creating a Flatonia Parks Conservancy, which would open the Committee up to more opportunities for funding. She also proposed using the Fayette Community Foundation to help establish the non-profit.

Deliberation Agenda

1. Committee member Sears, with a second from Committee member Horn, moved to approve making the following changes to Exhibit A:

- Remove “add a water fountain, add bleachers to the soccer field,” and “add mulch to the playscape.”
- Add “privacy fence on the south property line by the soccer field,” “add a privacy fence on the first base side of the softball field,” and “add a roof over the swimming pool bathrooms.”

The vote was unanimous. Motion passed.

2. Committee member Stavinoha, seconded by Committee Vice Chair Brazill, moved to approve replacing the crepe myrtles and painting the light posts at the entrance of McWhirter Park as the LCRA Steps Forward Program project for Spring 2026. The vote was unanimous. Motion passed.

Adjournment

Committee Chair Targac adjourned the meeting at 6:53 p.m.


