Opening Agenda

Call to Order Committee Chair Targac called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Projects/Reports

1. City Manager Miller did not have an update on the Texas Parks and Wildlife Trail Grant. The grant is still in process.
2. City Manager Miller updated the committee on the LCRA Community Grant application. He plans to resubmit the same project (bridge over the drainage ditch) for the July deadline.

Consent Agenda

1. Committee member Horn moved, with a second from Committee member Bruns, to approve the meeting minutes from March 25, 2026. The vote was unanimous. The motion carried.

Discussion Agenda

1. The committee reviewed the items on Exhibit A. City Manager Miller stated he spoke with the Flatonia Youth Sports and Events about finding someone to install the concrete pad at the soccer field as part of their LCRA Community Grant award. Committee member Sears brought up the need for an interlocal agreement for the right to use the public space.
2. The committee discussed how to set up the committee board for the new parks 501(c)(3). Committee member Horn would like to have all paperwork ready to go by July 15, 2026. There will need to be a special meeting on July 8, 2026, to formally vote to move forward.
3. The committee discussed accepting a donation of land and development of a small park by the Keep Flatonia Beautiful group. The park will be on the corner of East 6th and Penn Streets. Greg Ring from Keep Flatonia Beautiful was present to provide details. The committee would like to see a final design before recommending approval to the Council.
4. The committee discussed parking issues at 7-Acre Park along Garbade Lane during soccer events.

5. The committee discussed shade structures for the City pool and splashpad. They would like this project to take precedence over all others.

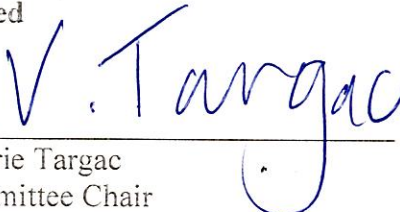
• **Deliberation Agenda**

Committee Chair Targac adjourned the meeting at 6:55 p.m.

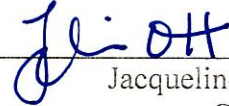
